

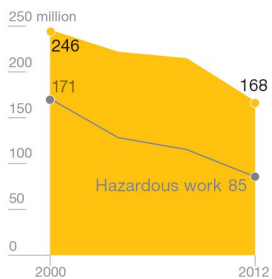
Child Labour Worldwide

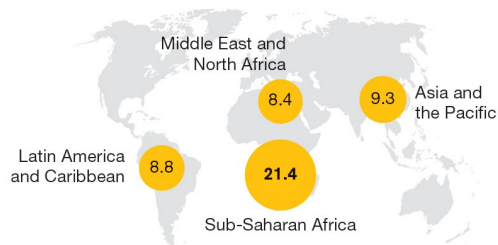
In the world, 126 million of children are exploited: that's 1/10 . Most of them work to help their family. But they can't go to school. Later they can't earn enough money and there children must work to. It's a vicious circle. This is the interview of a young Pakistani girl: Pharadis.

This girl is working in a brick factory from 6am to 6pm with her sister and her mother. Pharady's father died 5 years ago and left her with her mother and her 4 sisters to raise. Since then, they work in the brick factory but they still don't have enough money. It's a hazardous work: the temperatures are above 35° and she is paid by the bricks. Pharady's mother is getting older, she needs her to earn money.

The girl wants to become a teacher but if she doesn't go to school, it's impossible. *"I'm afraid, I won't be able to work later, to have enough money"*.
